I know that rehearsals may end early from time to time, and that it is my responsibility to tell my child what to do in such cases (walk home, wait in a designated spot at school, or wait in the office.) I understand the following:

- Rehearsals will be every Tuesday and Friday, from 2:40 to 3:30, in the multipurpose room or music room.
- Students with more than one unexcused absence will not be allowed participate in the next performance.
- Students are expected to attend performances, unless Mr. Snapp announces that participation is optional.
- Student who cannot behave appropriately, including after school before the rehearsal starts, will not be allowed in choir.
- Schoolwork comes first. If a child's teacher says that he or she is struggling in school then he or she will have to quit choir.
- Transportation arrangements are my responsibility, not Mr. Snapp's, including the times when a rehearsal is cancelled or ends early.
- I agree to provide black pants or a black skirt, black socks, and black shoes for formal performances.
