S it with proper posture.	Sitting with proper posture means you will pay better attention to lessons, and interact more in classroom discussions and activities.
L ean forward, look and listen.	Lean forward in your desk. This will indicate you are interested in the lesson. Look at the person talking, this shows them you are listening.
A sk pertinent questions.	Ask meaningful questions about class activities, discussions, and lectures. Your question may help many more students understand the lesson.
N od your head “yes” and no” with sincerity.	By nodding your head “yes” or “no” you indicate your understanding of the lesson. This interaction is a form of non-verbal communication during lectures.
T alk with teachers.	Successful students take the initiative to seek out their teachers before and after class to confirm understanding, to check grading discrepancies, and to obtain assignments after an absence.
