## Sculptures

The Kinders have really been enjoying our art time with Mrs. Aerhart. We have been learning about different types of lines and the different ways we can incorporate them into our art. ## Science

The Kinderkids are currently studying weather as part of our science curriculum. We have conducted a science experiment learning that water left in an open container evaporates (goes into the air), but water in a closed container does not. We have conducted an experiment where students learned water can be a liquid or a solid and can be made to change back and forth from one to the other. And although we have had lots of rainy days, Kinders have learned changes in weather occur from day to day and over seasons.
