Read & Feed Next Thursday!

This special edition is to let parents know that we will be having a “Read & Feed” next Thursday, November 13. We won't be having a spelling list because of the short week, so it seemed a good time to try this.

I've never done a Read & Feed before, but most of the students have in other classes, and they've told me what one consists of. Basically, parents send snacks to school. We put them on a table. We read silently for an hour or two, then we eat some snacks, then we read some more.

Here are the guidelines:

- We are asking that you send some sort of healthy snack to school next Thursday – crackers, deviled eggs, cookies, pretzels, etc. (The kids had plenty of suggestions so ask them. However, no candy or doughnuts, please.)
- Kids can also bring something to make their reading more comfortable – a pillow, a blanket, a beach chair, a bean bag chair, etc. (However, **NO STUFFED ANIMALS.**)
- To make things even cozier, the kids have convinced me to allow them to wear pajamas to school (or they can put their pajamas in a bag and change when they get here.)

If your child will be bringing anything that needs to go back home – a beach chair, a blanket, a food platter, etc. – please make arrangements to come and get it at the end of school on Thursday. I'd like to avoid having a bunch of stuff left here. Thank you.
